General Tollway Comments

- Congestion-Relief Program delivering steady improvements
- Becoming a leader in innovation and technology

Planning

- Regional approach to prioritizing projects and investments
- Comprehensive planning for local interchanges
- Focus on congestion relief, economic development, environmental concerns and return on investment
- Elgin O'Hare West Bypass and I-90 Advisory Councils setting new standard for infrastructure planning
- Continue to plan for future projects



What We Heard

Financing

- Support for toll increase must provide good value
- Develop a tool for indexing tolls or incremental revenue
- Congestion pricing/managed lanes needed
- Local participation needed, but need to consider local communities' ability to finance
- Must work collaboratively and use multiple sources of funding

Construction

- Tollway can't build its way out of congestion
- Focus on projects that improve regional mobility first
- Coordinate projects with CMAP, IDOT and local agencies
- Green construction important



What We Heard

Transit

- Planning for transit must be included in new roadways
- Rail and bus planning critical for O'Hare to Rockford area
- Coordinate with county and local bus rapid transit plans
- Bus can be used to prove need before investing in rail

Economic Development

- Infrastructure investment for congestion relief needed to attract and retain business in Illinois
- Tollway access and improvements key to global competitiveness
- Focus on projects with the "biggest bang for the buck"
- Consider improvements that enhance tourism signage
- Tollway system provides mobility for employees and trades
- Need to link economies across Northern Illinois
