Work Plan: Next 6 Months

- Non-Tolled Ramp Review
 - Review all existing access points and tolls
 - Present and discuss issues associated with free movements and non-tolled ramps
- Environmental and Sustainability Policy
 - Adopt a Move Illinois Program agency-wide Environmental and Sustainability Policy
 - Address capital, operations and maintenance investments



Work Plan: Next 6 Months

- Traffic Noise Policy
 - Evaluate existing Traffic Noise and Abatement Policy
 - Recommend changes to reflect Move Illinois Program
- Cost Share Policy
 - Cost share policy considerations for noisewalls, aesthetics, landscaping, bridges, lighting, bike/ped accommodations, transit, etc.
 - Typically addressed these on a project-by-project basis
 - Develop an official policy for cost sharing and reimbursement

Work Plan: 6-12 Months

- Interchange Policy Updates/Priorities
 - Consider investment prioritization and cost-sharing for future interchanges
 - Existing partial interchanges vs. new access
 - Operational improvements
 - Equity considerations rural and underserved regions
- Congestion Pricing
 - Review prior and ongoing studies to guide future investments and policies

Work Plan: 6-12 Months

- Land Use and ROW Evaluation
 - ☐ Evaluate current use of land
 - Review options to maximize and leverage use of land
 - economic development, renewable energy projects, park-n-ride, landscaping, excess/sale, utility easement/lease
- Multimodal Planning
 - Review policies for multi-modal accommodations
 - Use of roadway, right-of-way, access ramps, etc.
 - Discuss partnership opportunities



Work Plan: 6-12 Months

■ Freight Planning

- Evaluate and enact policies to enhance the movement of freight on the Tollway
- Commercial parking expansion
- Commercial routing, overweight permitting and accessibility
- Logistic and communication enhancements
- Intermodal planning



Work Plan: 12+ Months

- Signage Policy
 - Evaluate current sign policies
 - Attraction signs
 - Blue Board Pilot Program
 - Guide signs
- Innovative Financing Strategies
 - Leverage public and private resources
 - Review financing strategies
 - Value capture, federal grants, private investment, public agency partnerships, etc.
