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Purpose

Information on construction activity, traffic shifts, stage changes, variances or any other activity that will impact traffic on the Tollway and/or local roads and nearby communities must be reported in advance to the Construction Corridor Manager (CCM), Construction Manager (CM), Design Engineering (DSE). Lane Closures at laneclosures@getipass.com (x4822 & 4821), Elyse Morgan (x1703), Construction Communications Coordinators (CCC) Vacant (x6381) and Maria Burnham (x6389).

In addition to lane closure information, any other activity or issues that may impact Tollway customers should be communicated to the CCC as soon as possible.

The information in this Lane Closure Reference Guide provides directions for filling out any form that must be submitted to the Tollway when requesting any lane/shoulder closure(s).

DO NOT REFORMAT ANY FORM FOR ANY REASON UNLESS INSTRUCTED IN THIS DOCUMENT. WHEN THE DIRECTIONS ARE FOLLOWED THERE IS NO REASON TO REFORMAT A FORM.

Also included are procedures that have been sent via email and additional information that will help along the way.

Contract Information Page

When the Notice to Proceed (NTP) or Authorization Letter has been issued for a new contract, the Resident Engineer/Contractor must fill out a Contract Information Page and then email it to Lane Closures - laneclosures@getipass.com & Elyse Morgan - emorgan@getipass.com before the first request has been submitted. A Standard Lane/Shoulder Closure or Long Term Lane/Shoulder Closure request CAN NOT be approved and processed without the Contract Information Page and a signed NTP/Authorization Letter.

Below are detailed directions for filling out the Contract Information Page. Page 6 is a sample of what the page should look like after all the information has been input. Make sure that every section is filled in and is correct before submitting to the Tollway. Again, submit the Contract Information Page to laneclosures@getipass.com & emorgan@getipass.com before the first request has been submitted. **Only one (1) phone number per section can be processed.**

ALL PHONE NUMBERS THAT ARE PROVIDED ARE TO BE 24/7 NUMBERS. NO CALL SHOULD GO TO VOICE MAIL.

- 1) **Contract/Permit Number:** Type the contract/permit number listed on the NTP/Authorization Letter (i.e. I-12-1234/TS 16-1234)
- 2) **Location:** Type the location of the project listed on the NTP/Authorization Letter (i.e. IL 56 to Maple Av)
- 3) **Type of Work:** Type the type of work listed on the NTP/Authorization Letter (Pavement Resurfacing, Bridge Widening, etc.)
- 4) **Milepost(s):** Type the starting milepost of the project and the ending milepost of the project listed on the NTP/Authorization Letter (see pages 7 & 34 for entering milepost numbers),
- 5) **Maint. Sect.:** Type the Maintenance Section the project is in (M1, M2, M3, etc.) List A
- 6) **M.O.T. Company:** Type the Maintenance of Traffic Company (company setting up closures)
- 7) **Office Phone:** Type the MOT office phone number
- 8) **Cell Phone:** Type the cell number of the MOT (**MUST be a 24/7 number**)
- 9) **CM/DSE:** Type the CM or DSE (Construction Manager or Design Engineering company name)
- 10) **Office Phone:** Type the office number of the CM or DSE
- 11) **Resident Engineer:** Type the Resident Engineer's name (CM or DSE point of contact person)
- 12) **Cell Phone:** Type the cell phone number of the RE (**MUST be a 24/7 number**)
- 13) **Home Phone:** Type the home phone number of the RE (**MUST be a 24/7 number**)
- 14) **Field Phone:** Type the phone number of the field office
- 15) **Contractor:** Type the name of the contractor (company doing the work on the Tollway). It should NOT be blank.
- 16) **Office Phone:** Type the office number of the contractor
- 17) **Tollway Project Manager:** Type the name of the Tollway Project Manager
- 18) **Ext:** Type the Tollway extension of the Tollway PM
- 19) **Cell Phone:** Type the cell phone number of the Tollway PM
- 20) **Home Phone:** Type the home phone number of the Tollway PM

Lane Closure Requests & Revisions Due

It is a requirement that Daily Lane Closure Requests & Revisions for daytime and overnight work are due to the Tollway **BEFORE 9:00 AM** as follows:

Tuesday work is due Monday **BEFORE 9:00 AM**

Wednesday work is due Tuesday **BEFORE 9:00 AM**

Thursday work is due Wednesday **BEFORE 9:00 AM**

Friday work is due Thursday **BEFORE 9:00 AM**

Saturday, Sunday & Monday work is due Friday **BEFORE 9:00 AM**

If requests are not in **BEFORE 9:00 AM** or **submitted earlier (unless instructed by Lane Closures)** on day specified above they will not be approved and published on the Lane Closure Report.

Emergency closures will be taken on a case by case basis (see page 30 of this document).

ANY AND ALL CONFLICTS MUST BE RESOLVED BEFORE 9:00 AM. IF CONFLICTS ARE NOT RESOLVED BOTH LANE CLOSURES WILL BE DENIED.

Your email subject line **MUST** include Contract/Permit Number and Date of Closure.

Make sure that the form is filled out correctly: Contract/Permit number or Local Road name **MUST** be in the Contract # column. Type of Work **MUST** be filled in. Mileposts **MUST** be listed little to big regardless of direction.

The information at the bottom **MUST** be filled in correctly before submitting:

Approved for submittal Name, Title, Company Name, Phone Number

Submitted by (person who is sending the request), Title, Company Name, Phone Number

Date and Time request is being submitted to Tollway.

Ask for a Read Receipt

Designate a read and/or delivery receipt within the e-mail to assure delivery. *Follow up with a phone call **ONLY** if the e-mail read/delivery receipt is not verified.*

Breakdown of Daytime & Overnight Hours when filling out Lane Closure Requests

Daytime Hours 7:00 am to 7:00 pm

Overnight Hours 7:00 pm to 7:00 am

WHEN SUBMITTING A REVISION, MAKE SURE THAT WHAT HAS BEEN CHANGED IS IN RED.

Published Lane Closure Report

The published lane closure report is emailed out at approximately 2:00 PM Monday through Friday. Take a moment to review the daily Lane Closure Report once you receive it to make sure that your closure is on the report and that it is correct.

This way everyone can be notified if a closure did not make the report or if there is a correction that needs to be made before Maintenance leaves at 3:00 PM.

Reporting Lane Closure Status Procedure

The Construction Manager/ Design Engineer (CM/DSE) must contact the Traffic Center when the contractor starts to take **each** lane(s)/shoulder out of service, then when **each** lane is put back into service regardless if they are on the Mainline, ramp or at a Plaza (i.e. call when you start taking out your single lane, then call again when you start taking out your double lane closure and then again when you start taking out your triple lane closure), when the 1st vehicle occupies the lane/shoulder and if/when a lane configuration changes (i.e. the mile posts that are on the report have changed, multiple stops for a moving closure).

All shoulder closures in the SMART corridor on I-90 & I-294 Central Tri-State MUST be called in.

For lane & SMART/I-294 Central Tri-State corridor notifications (twenty-four hours a day), the CM/DSE shall notify:

The CM/DSE shall provide the Traffic Center the following information when they make all calls:

Contract/Permit Number
Corridor (road), Direction, start & end milepost
Lane(s)/shoulder taking out of service
Contact Information (name & call back phone number)

For overnight closures that cause a back-up of five (5) miles or greater, the CM/DSE shall notify:

The Tollway Traffic Center can be reached at **331-238-1772**.

The CM/DSE shall provide the Traffic Center the following information when they make all calls:

Contract/Permit Number
Corridor (road), Direction, start & end milepost
Approximate length of the backup and/or the location of where the traffic is backed up to.

- After the CM/DSE contacts Traffic Center, they shall call their PM and inform them of the back-up and that they have contacted Traffic Center.

Closures not being picked up on time prior to their scheduled removal, Emergency extension approval are needed if the closure is being delayed in removal. Follow Emergency Lane Closure Request Procedure on page 30.

If hours for scheduled closure (what is on the published report) change a revision must be submitted the next day. Example: If closure was to begin at 7:00 PM until 5:00 AM (what is on the published Lane Closure Report) and the CM/DSE calls in that they are closing the lane at 8:00 PM, then a revision needs to be submitted the following day. The same applies for putting the lane back into service.

- * **For overnight lane closures that cause a back-up of 5 miles or greater Dispatch will send a Critical Page.**

Standard Lane/Shoulder Closure Requests

Information on start of construction, traffic shifts, stage changes, variances or any other activity that will impact traffic on the Tollway and/or local roads, as well as nearby communities, must be reported in advance. This includes closures on any local roads in addition to ramp/plaza and mainline lane closures. A scheduled or contract closure typically includes a MOT plan that has been previously submitted, reviewed and approved. Notification shall state when lane closure will start, where the lane closure is located, direction of travel, lane(s) involved, and description of the closure and the duration of the closure.

Below are directions for filling out a Standard Lane/Shoulder Closure Request (daily lane closure). Page 11 is what the request should look like after all the information has been input. Make sure that every section is filled out correctly before submitting to the Tollway. Submit requests to CCC, Elyse Morgan and Lane Closures.

- 1) **Daytime or Overnight Day:** Type the day of closure (i.e. Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, etc.)
- 2) **Date of Closure:** Type the date of the closure (i.e. 1/21/14)
- 3) **Tollway #:** Type the Tollway number/Local Road name (i.e. I-90, I-94, Maple Av, etc.)
- 4) **Contract/Permit or Maint. Bldg. Number:** Type the contract/permit or maintenance number (i.e. I-12-1234)
- 5) **Mileposts:** Type the starting milepost number and the ending milepost number (little to big regardless of which direction, i.e. 96.8 to 97.9). List A
- 6) **Direction:** Type the direction of closure (i.e. EB, WB, SB, NB)
- 7) **Nearest Underpass/Overpass:** Type the starting nearest underpass/overpass to ending nearest underpass/overpass (i.e. Single Rd to Triple Rd). List A
- 8) **Type of Work:** Type the type of work listed (i.e. Pavement Striping). List B
- 9) **Lane(s)/Shoulder Closed:** Type the lane(s)/shoulder that will be closed (i.e. Left Lane). List C
- 10) **Lane(s)/Shoulder Open:** Type the lane(s)/shoulder that will be open (i.e. 2 Right Lanes). List C
- 11) **Times of Closure:** Type the start time to the end time of closure (i.e. 7:00 pm -6:00 am)
- 12) **Approved for submittal by:** Type the Resident Engineer's name that will be approving the request
- 13) **Title:** Type the Resident Engineer's title
- 14) **Company:** Type the Resident Engineer's company
- 15) **Phone #:** Type the Resident Engineer's phone number (24/7)
- 16) **Emailed by:** Type your name
- 17) **Title:** Type your title
- 18) **Company:** Type your company
- 19) **Phone #:** Type your phone number (24/7)
- 20) **Date submitted to Tollway:** Type the date request is submitted to the Tollway
- 21) **Time submitted to Tollway:** Type the time request is submitted to the Tollway
- 22) **If this is a revision,:** Leave blank

Revisions to Lane Closure Requests

Below are directions for filling out a revision to a Standard Lane/Shoulder Closure Request that has been submitted to the Tollway. Page 14 is the Standard Lane/Shoulder Closure Request that has been submitted to the Tollway. Page 13 is what the revision should look like after making changes. Make sure that every section is filled out correctly before submitting to the Tollway. Submit revisions to CCC, TIMS, Elyse Morgan and Lane Closures.

- 1) Open original lane closure request that was submitted
- 2) Save a copy
- 3) Check to make sure that the Save in section lists the location of where the new form will be filed
- 4) Rename document (make sure that revision is in the title)
- 5) Make changes to the request in red
- 6) Down at the bottom of the page change the following information:
 - Date submitted:** Type the date revision is submitted to the Tollway
 - Time submitted:** Type the time revision is submitted to the Tollway
 - If this is a revision,** Type 1 after the # sign

Cancellation of Lane Closure Request

The cancellation of a lane closure(s) should be sent to Tollway immediately (**before 1:00 PM** if possible). Cancellations must be communicated immediately to the Incident Manager, CCC, TIMS, Elyse Morgan and Lane Closures as outlined on the lane closure form. **This DOES NOT mean that you can cancel part of a lane closure request and ADD a closure. That is a REVISION (refer to page 7 of this document).**

During business hours, Monday through Friday, 7 am to 3 pm, the CM/DSE shall email the CCC, TIMS (x1772), Elyse Morgan and Lane Closures.

During after-hours/holiday, from 3 pm to 7 am, weekends and holidays, all lane closures that have been changed (with prior approval by the Tollway)/cancelled should be directed to the Tollway Traffic Center at 630-241-6800 x1772 with a follow up email to CCC, Incident Manager, Elyse Morgan and Lane Closures.

Below are directions for filling out a cancellation to a Standard Lane/Shoulder Closure Request that has already been submitted to the Tollway. Page 17 is the Standard Lane/Shoulder Closure Request that has been submitted to the Tollway. Page 16 is what the cancellation should look like after the changes.

- 1) Open original lane closure request that you submitted
- 2) Save a copy
- 3) Check to make sure that the Save in section lists the location of where the new form will be filed
- 4) Rename document (make sure that cancellation is in the title)
- 5) Select all of the information that has been cancelled
- 6) Go to Home tab then font section and change the color to red
- 7) In the font dialog box check single strikethrough
- 8) Down at the bottom of the page change the following information:
 - Date submitted:** Type the date cancellation is submitted to the Tollway
 - Time submitted:** Type the time cancellation is submitted to the Tollway
 - If this is a revision,** Type Cancellation after the # sign

10 Day Advance Lane/Shoulder Closure Request

For any project with major disruption of traffic, especially for medium or long term duration, start of new construction, major traffic shift, stage change, closing ramps, closing mainline or local roads for any time duration (includes intermittent Full Closures) or whenever construction activity will have a new and/or significant impact to traffic movements and flow, a 10 Day Advance Lane/Shoulder Closure Request must be submitted. This information is for Media-Alert purposes only; no closures are “Permitted” with this request. The information will give the Tollway time to notify the weekday and weekend drivers, issue accurate and timely press releases/construction alerts to the media and draft content of Portable Changeable Message Sign (PCMS)/Dynamic Message Sign (DMS) messages.

Below are directions on how to fill out a 10 Day Advanced Lane/Shoulder Closure Request. Page 20 is a sample of what the request should look like after all the information has been input. Make sure that every section is filled out correctly before submitting to the Tollway. Submit requests to CCC, TIMS, Elyse Morgan and Lane Closures.

NOTE: A Standard Lane/Shoulder Request still needs to be submitted. When the 10 Day Advance Lane/Shoulder Closure Request is submitted to the Tollway, the start date for the work to begin should be no less than **10 DAYS FROM THE DATE REQUEST WAS SUBMITTED NO EXCEPTIONS.** If the date on a 10 Day Advance Lane/Shoulder Closure Request is delayed, a revised 10 Day Advance Lane/Shoulder Closure Request must be sent in.

- 1) **Daytime or Overnight Day:** Type the day of closure (i.e. Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, etc.)
- 2) **Date of Closure:** Type the date of the closure (i.e. 1/21/14)
- 3) **Tollway Number:** Type the Tollway number/Local Road name (i.e. I-90, I-94, Maple Av, etc.)
- 4) **Contract/Permit or Maintenance Number:** Type the contract/permit or maintenance number (i.e. I-12-1234)

Include the mileposts, direction, crossroads, lanes closed and open and the hours of the request. Email to everyone you normally do and include the Incident Manager asking for approval for the request.

SUBJECT: EMERGENCY LANE CLOSURE/HOLIDAY REQUESTS/OR AFTER BUSINESS HOURS REQUEST 3PM-7AM

1. When an emergency repair/action is needed the standard lane/shoulder closure request form still must be completed, even though the approval process can occur verbally.
2. The Construction Manager and Project Manager must approve the request and forward the request to Lane Closures.
3. The CCM and/or the CM and/or the Project Manager must obtain the Tollway's approval through direct verbal contact with the Incident Manager or in his absence the Roadway Maintenance Manager.
4. Incident Manager's approval of Emergency Lane Closures shall be limited to a bona fide Emergency Condition that effect safe and efficient performance of the Toll road. Failure to meet established deadlines for daily lane closures alone will not qualify for approval by the Incident Manager. These requests will be denied.
5. After receiving Tollway approval, the CCM and/or CM must directly notify Communications **Vacant x6381, Lane Closures via email, Traffic Center x1772**, Maintenance Section Manager and Plaza Manager (if applicable). The Incident Manager / Roadway Maintenance District Manager / Roadway Maintenance Manager will advise Traffic Center/Dispatch and ISP Operations that the Emergency Closure has been approved and the Dispatch will send out a critical page with the closure information, further signifying Tollway approval of the Emergency Closure.
6. Late requests for lane closures as a rule will not be allowed unless approval is received from the Incident Manager.

Your assistance in notifying the Construction Team Managers is requested.

Tollway/CM/Contractor PCMS Deployment and Maintenance Guide

The information herein is intended as a reference guide regarding the use of TIMS-compatible Portable Changeable Message Signs (PCMS) when deployed on Tollway construction sites. When a construction contract requires the use of TIMS-compatible signs, the placement of the signs will be spelled out in the Maintenance and Traffic standards required in the construction contract document. It is important to note that the construction contract may allow non-TIMS-compatible signs. However, when a contract requires the use of TIMS-compatible signs the contractor must use these signs; no alternates are allowed.

The TIMS-compatible signs outlined and listed in the construction contract documents are designed to communicate with the Tollway's Traffic and Incident Management System (TIMS). This communication uses specialized software developed for this purpose. The construction contracts identify signs by make and model, which are TIMS pre-qualified and can be used on Tollway construction projects.

Due to the programming of messages by TIMS, knowing the exact location of all signs is critical. **The Traffic Center is to be notified immediately before signs are moved to new locations or taken off the job.** If a sign loses communication with TIMS for any reason (i.e. struck by vehicle, equipment failure, etc.), it is responsibility of the contractor to ensure replacement within 24 hours.

The following is information to answer many questions on the use of PCMS's on Tollway construction projects.

1. When Full Matrix or TIMS-compatible PCMS's are required to be used on Tollway construction sites, the signs to be used on the sites are to be delivered to the Tollway's Central Shop (3460 S. Finley Rd Downers Grove IL) before placement at the job site. This applies to all signs going onto a Tollway job for the first time, as well as signs that have not been on a Tollway project for more than 90 days.
2. All correspondence regarding PCMS signs with the Tollway's Traffic Center and Communications Department is to include the Tollway PCMS sign identifier number placed on the sign by the Tollway.
3. Full Matrix PCMS's are to be programmable by the Tollway's TIMS system. The quantity of TIMS-compatible PCMS's per direction of work zone will be spelled out in the Maintenance of traffic portion of the contract specifications.
4. The CM is responsible for formulating messages for approval by the Tollway's Incident Manager for preconstruction messages.
5. The CM is to submit a weekly report of all PCMS's used in his/her construction zone. That report will contain Owner, Tollway Sign Number, Location, currently displayed message and contact information to be used to report malfunctions or for sign status inquiries. This report will be uploaded to e-builder every Monday.
6. The weekly report will be revised and submitted each time a move occurs to any TIMS-programmable PCMS.
7. Automated Vehicle Location systems (AVL) on all TIMS compatible signs are to remain on/powerd and correctly reporting while on a Tollway project.

8. AVL is to be turned off or disabled if a TIMS compatible PCMS is removed from a Tollway project.
9. The age and sign quality is of importance and signs that do not meet the standards of the Tollway will not be allowed on projects. Signs that are in poor physical appearance or that have more than three failures in a 12 month period must be removed and not returned.
10. Any sign replacing a TIMS-compatible sign for maintenance or repairs must be a Tollway approved sign marked with a Tollway identifying number and be TIMS compatible.
11. As construction contracts close and PCMS's are ready to be taken off the site, the Traffic Center is to be notified of the move. The CM is to verify with the Tollway Project Manager the status of the TIMS-compatible signs.

Other Lane Closure Details

Published Lane Closure Report

The published lane closure report is emailed out at approximately 2:00 PM Monday through Friday. Take a moment to review the daily Lane Closure Report once you receive it to make sure that your closure is on the report and that it is correct.

This way everyone can be notified if a closure did not make the report or if there is a correction that needs to be made before Maintenance leaves at 3:00 PM.

Breakdown of Daytime & Overnight Hours when filling out Lane Closure Requests

Daytime Hours 7:00 am to 7:00 pm

Overnight Hours 7:00 pm to 7:00 am

Subject Line When Emailing Closures

When emailing your lane closure to the Tollway you need to add in the subject line, the contract number, date of closure and if the closure is a day or night closure (i.e. 1234-10242006-Night).

Ask for a Read Receipt

Designate a read and/or delivery receipt within the e-mail to assure delivery. Follow up with a phone call ONLY if the e-mail read/delivery receipt is not verified.

Entering Milepost Numbers

Type the lowest number first, then the largest number (i.e. 96.8 to 97.9) **Regardless which corridor or direction.**

Type **ONE (1) milepost number** for ramp & plaza closures.

List A is a list of all the milepost numbers for the crossroads for each corridor.

List D is a list all of the milepost numbers for the ramps for each corridor.

List of Lanes Closed & Opened

List C is a list of wording to use when stating which lanes will be closed and which lanes will be open.

- When you close a right or left lane you are also closing the shoulder. You **DO NOT** need to list shoulder.
- When closing a shoulder use right shoulder or left shoulder **NOT** inside shoulder or outside shoulder.

DO NOT USE LANE NUMBERS.

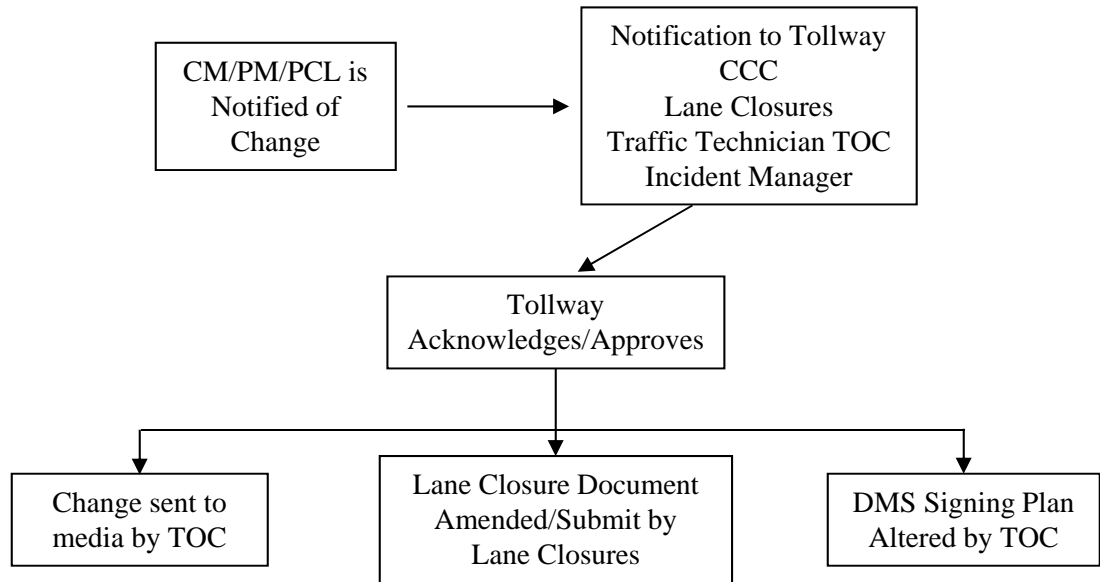
