Regular Board of Directors Meeting

Record of Meeting | June 22, 2017

The Illinois State Toll Highway Authority (the "Tollway") Board of Directors met in regular session on Thursday, June 22, 2017 in the Boardroom of Tollway Headquarters in Downers Grove, Illinois. The Meeting was held pursuant to By-Laws of the Tollway upon call and notice of the Meeting executed by Chairman Robert J. Schillerstrom and posted in accordance with the requirements of the Illinois *Open Meetings Act.* The Meeting was open to the public.

Call to Order / Pledge of Allegiance / Roll Call

The Board Secretary declared a quorum present.

Public Comment

Chairman Schillerstrom opened the floor for public comment. No public comment was offered.

Chairman's Items

Item 1: Approval of the Minutes of the regular Board of Directors meeting held May 25, 2017.

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Chairman Schillerstrom called for a motion to approve **Chairman's Item 1**, the Minutes of the regular Board of Directors meeting held on May 25, 2017, as presented. Director Banks made a motion for approval; seconded by Director Johnson. Chairman Schillerstrom asked if there are any questions, concerns or requests for amendment. Hearing nothing, Chairman Schillerstrom called for a vote. The motion was PASSED unanimously.

Chairman Schillerstrom stated that without objection, action on **Chairman's Item 2**, concerning the minutes of closed meetings, will be deferred until after consideration in Executive Session.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Chairman Schillerstrom asked the chair of the following committee of the Board if he had any report to provide on the committee's recent activities:

Finance, Administration & Operations Committee

Committee Chair Gomez updated the Board on the Finance, Administration and Operations Committee ("FAO Committee") meeting held Wednesday, June 14, 2017, providing the following highlights:

FINANCE presented one item which the Committee recommended placing on the full Board agenda. The committee approved a pool of 28 firms eligible to provide underwriting services for Tollway bond issues. The pool of firms includes 14 senior managing underwriters and 14 co-managing underwriters. Firms were selected pursuant to a request for proposal and all firms are expected to be utilized during the initial three year term.

PROCUREMENT presented four items which the FAO Committee approved for placement on the full Board agenda:

- One award of a Tollway request for proposal to purchase a diversity management application, consistent with an Executive Order issued by Governor Rauner in July 2016,
- One award of a Tollway request for proposal to purchase email distribution services, and
- Two awards of Tollway invitations for bid; one to purchase LED lights and one for Freightliner truck repairs on an as-needed basis.

ENGINEERING presented 11 items which were each reviewed and approved by the Committee for placement on the Board agenda with a recommendation for approval:

• Two construction contract awards including a small business set aside contract with a first time prime that is also a Hispanic women-owned firm. Of the approximately \$4 million recommended for award, \$672 thousand or 17% is committed to diverse or small firms.

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- Five professional service contract awards, including a contract to engage the Tollway's new General Engineering Consultant. Of the \$99.4 million recommended for award, nearly \$39 million or 39% is committed to diverse, veteran or small firms.
- Three professional service contract supplements, providing for additional fiber optic maintenance and management services, additional consulting engineer services, and for additional design corridor management and design services for the Central Tri-State Tollway (I-294) Project.
- One construction change order.

The last two Engineering items, concerning land acquisition activities, were deferred at Committee and will be reviewed in Executive Session today prior to full Board consideration.

LEGAL presented two items which were each approved for placement on the Board agenda: an intergovernmental agreement allowing for the transfer of excess Tollway real estate parcels to Cook County, and a real estate lease concerning approximately 7,270 square feet of Tollway-owned real estate situated near I-90 and Lee Street.

The remaining three Legal items, related to litigation settlements and the appointment of counsel, were deferred at Committee and will be reviewed in Executive Session prior to full Board consideration.

Additionally, Committee Chair Gomez concluded his Committee report by congratulating Executive Director Greg Bedalov, who was recently named the 2017 Champion by the National Organization of Minority Engineers (NOME) in recognition of his efforts to promote diversity, inclusion and opportunities for minority businesses to work with the Tollway.

Having no further items, Chairman Schillerstrom called on Executive Director Greg Bedalov.

Executive Director's Items

MOVE IT Program: Executive Director Bedalov announced the kick-off of MOVE IT, a new program to encourage employee wellness. He invited anyone interested to register for any or all of the options in the program – a 292-mile challenge, the "A Safe Haven" 5k run in July, or joining up for a weekly walk/run group.

Publicity Club of Chicago: Executive Director Bedalov highlighted that the Tollway Communications team recently received two Golden Trumpet awards from the Publicity Club of Chicago. He reported that the awards recognized the Illinois Route 390 Tollway Community

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Outreach campaign and the media event held in January for the completion of the Jane Addams Memorial Tollway (I-90) Rebuilding and Widening Project.

Illinois State Police Heritage Motorcycle Run: Executive Director Bedalov announced that on July 15th Tollway Headquarters will serve as a starting point for the 10th Annual Illinois State Police Heritage Motorcycle Run held to fund the construction of a memorial park and to honor the lives of fallen Illinois State Troopers.

June 2017 Diversity Statistics: Executive Director Bedalov provided the following diversity statistics for Tollway procurements to be presented in the current month:

ENGINEERING has two construction contracts totaling \$4 million and five professional engineering services contracts totaling \$99.4 million, which include:

- Two firms doing business with the Tollway for the first time,
- Five Partnering for Growth (P4G) mentoring commitments, and
- One small business set-aside contract awarded as part of the Tollway's Small Business Initiative.

Of the \$103.4 million in recommended Engineering contract awards, nearly \$39.3 million, or 38 percent, is committed to small, veteran-owned or disadvantaged firms.

In addition, six contracts include commitments for disadvantaged, minority- and women-owned business enterprise (D/M/WBE) participation. D/M/WBE commitments range from 10 to 70 percent per contract:


- One prime contractor and one subcontractors are certified as D/M/WBEs.
- Four subconsultants are certified veteran-owned firms.
- Two prime consultants are certified as D/M/WBEs.
- 23 subconsultants are certified as D/M/WBEs.

PROCUREMENT has four goods and services contracts totaling \$1.5 million to present this month. These contracts include:

- One firm doing business with the Tollway for the first time as a prime vendor, and
- Two firms meeting or exceeding Illinois Business Enterprise Program (BEP) goals or veteran goals.


