DBE AND VETERAN GOALSETTING

- Since January, Diversity has used new Disparity Study data to set DBE goals on Tollway projects
- Diversity Department will take cautious approach to ensure setting achievable goals with meaningful DBE participation
- Diversity also reviewing veteran goals

ILLINOIS TOLLWAY: MAKING A CONNECTION

BALANCED PROJECT SUBMITTALS

- PSB submittals should reflect “balanced” team approach for:
 - Ethnicity
 - Gender
 - Responsibilities
- Provide meaningful opportunities so smaller firms can grow
- Utilize mix of experienced and new firms
- Diversity reviews level of diverse participation on submittals
- Tollway is considering set-asides for professional services

ILLINOIS TOLLWAY: MAKING A CONNECTION

PARTNERING FOR GROWTH (P4G) PROGRAM

- Encourages professional services consultants to provide meaningful instruction, technical assistance and beneficial resources to diverse and veteran-owned firms
 - Mentors earn credit toward DBE or veteran goals
 - Protégés receive beneficial assistance and training
 - Tollway benefits from increased competition in the marketplace
- 85 agreements assisting 56 minority, women or veteran-owned firms
