## Illinois State Police Announce Results of Roadside Safety Check in Kane County

**Downers Grove, IL** – The Illinois State Police (ISP) announced the results of a Roadside Safety Check (RSC) held during the late evening hours of Thursday, June 27, 2019, and early morning hours of Friday, June 28, 2019. The detail was conducted on the Reagan Memorial Tollway (I-88) on the exit ramp to Illinois Route 31 in Aurora by ISP District 15 officers.

Alcohol is involved in nearly 40 percent of fatal crashes in Illinois. RSCs are designed to remove alcohol-impaired drivers. However, when other violations are observed such as driving with a suspended or revoked license, operating a vehicle without a valid registration or insurance or safety belt violations, enforcement action may be taken. The following enforcement action was issued at the safety check:
