## **Illinois State Police Announce Results of Occupant Restraint Patrol in Cook and Lake Counties**

Downers Grove, IL – Illinois State Police District 15 Commander Dominic Chiappini announced today enforcement figures for an Occupant Restraint Enforcement Patrol (OREP) conducted on November 7 on the Jane Addams Memorial Tollway (I-90) in Cook and Kane counties.

Speeding citations	5
Speeding written warnings	2
All other citations	28
<b>Total citations issued</b>	<b>47</b>
<b>Total written warnings issued – all violations</b>	<b>5</b>

In 2017, nearly one in four of the 1,090 people killed in traffic crashes in Illinois were not wearing seatbelts, according to the Illinois Department of Transportation. The goal of the OREP program is to reduce traffic fatalities and serious injuries by strictly enforcing all occupant restraint laws in Illinois. This project is funded through the IDOT Division of Traffic Safety.
