The Toll Highway Act (605 ILCS 10/10(a-5)) allows the Illinois Tollway to establish, by rule, a system of civil administrative adjudication to adjudicate only alleged instances of a vehicle's operation on a toll highway without the required toll having been paid. Under the Act, a noticed recipient has a right to request a hearing to contest the toll-evasion allegations. The Act also requires that hearings be conducted by Hearing Officers who must be attorneys licensed in the State of Illinois for a minimum of five years.

The duties of Hearing Officers include presiding over the toll violation hearings, explaining the procedures of the hearing to the parties, listening to testimony, ruling on the admissibility of evidence and permitting parties to present evidence, permitting parties to examine and cross-examine witnesses, and issuing a final order indicating case findings.
