The 2020 Final Budget allocates \$1,535.0 million of revenue as follows:

- The M&O Budget is \$380.2 million, an increase of \$14.9 million or 4.1 percent above the 2019 Budget of \$365.4 million.
- Revenues of \$449.6 million are allocated for transfer to the Trustee for Debt Service. These revenues along with federal rebates for Build America Bonds will be utilized to meet debt service payments and related support costs.
- Revenues of \$705.2 million are allocated to the Renewal, Replacement and Improvement Accounts, providing a significant source of funding for the Move Illinois Program. These funds together with the bond proceeds will be available to fund the Tollway's \$1,461.5 million Capital Program.

# One-year extension of the Series 2008 A-1b Bondholder Agreement

**Contract #:** N/A

**Vendor:** RBC Municipal Products, LLC ("RBCMP" or "Vendor")

**Description:** Per the terms of the Bondholder Agreement with RBCMP supporting the Series

2008A-1b Bonds, the Vendor agrees to hold the bonds for a specified period of time at an interest rate equal to the 7-day SIFMA Index ("SIFMA"), an average rate of high-grade tax-exempt variable rate bonds, plus a spread. RBCMP purchased the bonds on February 3, 2017 for a three-year period at SIFMA plus a spread of 45 basis points (0.45%). This request is to extend that agreement approximately one year until

February 1, 2021, at SIFMA plus a spread of 50 basis points (0.50%).

**Scope:** Authorize an extension of the Bondholder Agreement between the Authority and

RBCMP for approximately one year, from February 3, 2020 to February 1, 2021.

**Amount:** The cost is essentially the spread charged over SIFMA, which is 50 basis points

(0.50%) during the period of extension. In dollar terms, given the \$188,550,000 par amount of the bonds on 2/3/2020, declining to \$187,450,000 on 1/1/2021, the 50 basis points cost is \$937,350. Such cost is subject to increase in the event of an Authority default or rating downgrade. Authorization to pay related upfront fees and reimburse

legal expenses is also requested.

The legacy Violation Processing System (and its associated Customer Service Center System) continues to enable the collection of aged debt, interfacing with the Tollway's collection agencies daily. And, although the systems have a significantly reduced processing footprint, as no new transactions are being added, customer service representatives also continue to take payments daily on the aged debt they hold.

The Host System processes 100% of the Tollway's one billion lane transactions annually, thus enabling our \$1.5 billion of annual revenues. The Violation Processing System (and its associated Customer Service Center System) is currently the repository for well over one billion transactions related to aged tolling debt. These systems are necessary to maintain uninterrupted revenues, including recovered revenues.

Today's electronic tolling technology and maintenance marketplace remains niche and evolving, which has made the breaking apart of the original large electronic tolling technology contract a slow process. While we continue to work on these last remaining parts of the original large contract, this sole economically feasible source contract will provide the lowest-risk option for preserving the integrity of the current roadways and will significantly mitigate the risk of revenue loss.
