



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Description: A Second Intergovernmental Agreement Addendum with the Northwest Suburban Municipal Joint Action Water Agency ("NSMJAWA")

Scope: In March 1984, the Illinois Tollway and the NSMJAWA entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement regarding the NSMJAWA's water transmission lines along I-90. In March 2014, the parties entered into a first addendum to the IGA to establish terms pursuant to which the NSMJAWA would reimburse the Illinois Tollway for work relating to relocation of those transmission lines in connection with the reconstruction of I-90. Per the first addendum, the NSMJAWA is required to reimburse the Illinois Tollway, on or before January 1, 2024, an amount not to exceed \$73,115,000. To date, the NSMJAWA has paid the Tollway \$6,000,000 and owes the Illinois Tollway an additional \$67,115,000. To obtain financial relief from the Illinois Tollway and other benefits, such as being able to better assist the municipalities it serves to remain competitive in attracting new business, the NSMJAWA proposes to prepay its remaining balance of \$67,115,000 to the Illinois Tollway in one lump sum payment no later than May 1, 2020. In exchange for the early lump sum payment, which will provide certainty of payment and financial benefit to the Illinois Tollway, the Illinois Tollway will grant the NSMJAWA a \$1.5 million discount, reducing its total reimbursement obligation to \$65,615,000.
