**Description:** This resolution authorizes the sale of Parcels N-8A-93.1EX, N-8A-93.2EX, N-8A-

93.3EX and N-8A-93.4EX, located east of Ruby Street and west of Ramp E in

Rosemont, Rosemont IL, in Cook County.

Scope: The Tollway acquired the parcels for the original I-90 and consists of Willow Creek

and existing floodway/floodplain. An existing village storm water pump station is located in the northwest corner of the parcels which was constructed in the late 1980's. The Village has always maintained the parcels including grass cutting, tree removal, debris and trash removal. School District 78 is contemplating a new facility

on their property adjoining the parcels to the north. Therefore, the Village of

Rosemont has requested the transfer in order to be able to consider any variances that may be requested by the school district during the design and permitting process.

The Excess Property Committee determined the parcels were excess to the Tollway's needs and approved the parcels to be sold via Intergovernmental Agreement for no less than the appraised fair market value of \$30,500.00. The property consists of

60,787 square feet (1.395 acres).

**Description:** An Intergovernmental Agreement with the Village of Indian Head Park ("Village")

Scope: In connection with the Central Tri-State Rehabilitation and Reconstruction Project

("Project"), the Tollway requires additional land for drainage and right-of-way purposes. After identifying Village property it could acquire for these purposes, the Tollway engaged in discussions with the Village, which resulted in the Tollway and the Village agreeing to a revised plan that will benefit both parties. Relative to the Tollway, the specific benefits of the revised plan are a better solution to the Tollway's drainage issues and lower land acquisition costs. This IGA documents (i) the Tollway's agreement to compensate the Village, in the amount of \$510,000, for property the Village will transfer to the Tollway (reducing the Tollway's Project-related land acquisition costs by more than \$225,000), (ii) the Tollway's agreement to provide support for Village

improvements on lands adjacent to Wolf Road and I-294, and (iii) the Village's agreement, pursuant to the Tollway's request, to perform certain traffic analysis prior to

making the improvements.
