> Previously, via Board Resolution No. 21771, the Board authorized the Tollway to contract with Ray O'Herron Company for vehicle lighting products and parts, for the term of 05/22/2019 through 09/30/2019, in an amount not to exceed \$400,000, which amount the Tollway fully exhausted in September 2019. CMS subsequently advised the Tollway that the master contract would expire on 09/30/2019 before a new contract would take effect. Because District 15 needed additional vehicle lighting products and parts, in September 2019, the Tollway processed a \$185,000 order against the master contract before it expired and included an informational item regarding the additional order in the January 2020 Board materials. The submission was consistent with prior practice, as set forth in Resolution Nos. 19668 and 19974, which authorize Tollway staff to approve CMS-based goods and services contracts below \$250,000 without seeking Board approval. Recently, this practice was reconsidered in instances where the not to exceed amount in the authorizing Resolution, such as Resolution No. 21771, has been exhausted. After review, the General Counsel advised that the practice should be revised and Board authorization would be required to pay for the \$185,000 order.
