## Illinois State Police Announce Results of Special Traffic Enforcement Patrols Results in Cook, DuPage, Kane, Lake, Will and Winnebago Counties

Downers Grove, IL – Illinois State Police District 15 Interim Commander Jason Bradley announced today enforcement figures for special Traffic Enforcement Patrols (sTEP) between June 15 and June 30 on the Jane Addams Memorial Tollway (I-90) in Cook, Kane and Winnebago counties, the Reagan Memorial Tollway (I-88) in DuPage and Kane counties, the Tri-State Tollway (I-94/I-294/I-80) in Cook and Lake counties and the Veterans Memorial Tollway (I-355) in DuPage and Will counties.

Slowing down and observing the speed limit not only saves lives, but also saves on gas. Additionally, safety belts are proven to be the most effective safety devices in vehicles today and are estimated to save over 15,000 lives each year. The sTEP program involves a combination of increased enforcement and community education designed to raise public awareness and compliance with all traffic laws. A special emphasis was placed on speeding, failure to wear a safety belt, DUI and other alcohol-related offenses.
