Illinois State Police Announce Results of Distracted Driving Enforcement Patrols in Cook, Kane and DuPage and Will Counties

Downers Grove, IL – Illinois State Police District 15 Commander Jason Bradley announced today enforcement figures for Distracted Driving Enforcement Patrols (DDEP) conducted between September 4 and September 7 on the Jane Addams Memorial Tollway (I-90) in Cook and Kane counties and the Veterans Memorial Tollway (I-355) in DuPage and Will counties.
