## **Illinois State Police Announce Results of Roadside Safety Check in Kane County**

**Downers Grove, IL** – The Illinois State Police (ISP) announced the results of a Roadside Safety Check (RSC) held in Kane County during the late evening hours of Saturday, October 10, 2020, and early morning hours of Sunday, October 11, 2020. The detail was conducted on the westbound Jane Addams Memorial Tollway (I-90) on the ramp to Illinois Route 31 in Elgin by ISP District 15 officers.

Alcohol is involved in nearly 40 percent of fatal crashes in Illinois. RSCs are designed to remove alcohol-impaired drivers. However, when other violations are observed such as driving with a suspended or revoked license, operating a vehicle without a valid registration or insurance or safety belt violations, enforcement action may be taken. The following enforcement action was issued at the safety check:
