





CENTRAL TRI-STATE TOLLWAY (I-294) PROJECT DATA THROUGH JUNE 2020










2020 PROJECT PROGRESS BY PHASE - YEAR TO DATE

The I-490 Tollway, coupled with the new Illinois Route 390 Tollway, will provide 17 miles of new toll roads and direct access to O'Hare International Airport.




