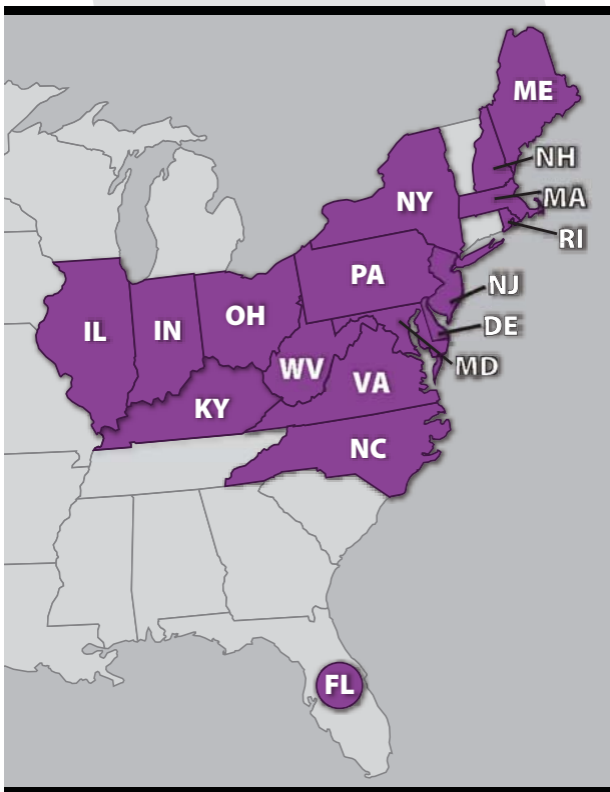

**I-PASS/E-ZPass cannot be used on Florida Turnpike Authority tollways. Only SunPass is accepted.*
