The Illinois Tollway's violation enforcement system has photographed your vehicle going through a toll plaza without proper payment. *You have thirty (30) days from the issue date of this notice to pay the total amount due, dispute the violations or request an administrative hearing to contest the violation(s) included with this notice.*

I-PASS, E-ZPass Customers

Please do not schedule a hearing. You may have received this notice because your account information is not current. Please call for assistance and have available your account number, violation notice number, license plate information and the last four digits of the driver's license number associated with your I-PASS account.

Notices are sent to registered owners who accumulate three or more toll violations over a one-year period. All violation notices are mailed within ninety (90) days of a registered owner's third violation. This means that up to two violations on this notice may be older than ninety (90) days. Notices sent as the result of a reassignment, i.e., rental vehicles, will include two or more violations regardless of the violation dates.

NOTICE OF TOLL VIOLATION

Late Payments/No Payment

Failure to respond to this notice within thirty (30) days of the issue date will be considered an admission of liability and you forfeit your right to an administrative hearing. A Final Order of Liability will be issued against you, by default, for the total amount due. You then have to pay the total amount due or you will face additional fines of \$50.00 per violation. To the extent allowable by the laws of your state, failure to satisfy any fine or penalty resulting from a Final Order for five (5) or more violations imposed by the Tollway may result in the Tollway petitioning the Secretary of State for the suspension of your vehicle registration and/or driver's license and possible forwarding of this matter to a private agency or law firm for collection action, including reporting it to a credit rating bureau.

About this Notice

Tollway customers are required by law to pay the required tolls at each toll plaza on the Illinois Tollway system. The registered owner of a vehicle that goes through a toll plaza without payment of the proper toll is responsible for any and all unpaid tolls or violations, whether or not the unpaid toll was intentional or if someone other than the registered owner was driving the vehicle.

Section 10/10(a-5) of the Illinois Toll Highway Act and sections 2520.269(e) and 2520.750 of the Illinois Administrative Code authorize the Tollway to adjudicate toll evasion violations administratively and assess a mandatory fine of \$20.00 per violation against the registered owner of a vehicle that has been recorded as failing to pay the proper toll.
